Each recycling program has guidelines based on available markets. Not following the guidelines causes contamination. Materials then must be landfilled. If contamination becomes a problem, customers may be charged for recycling in the future. Please check signs at the recycling center for any changes to the following guidelines.

NEWSPAPER

- ✓ Newspapers (the advertising inserts inside them are OK, too)
- ✗ No paper or plastic bags, etc., used to carry the newspapers
- ✗ No junk mail, office paper, or telephone books

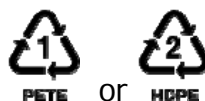
MAGAZINES AND CATALOGS

- ✓ High-gloss magazines, catalogs, and covers only of books with high-gloss covers
- ✗ No books, mixed paper, semi-gloss paper, or any other paper that isn't shiny

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

- ✓ Clean, dry, flattened *corrugated* cardboard (remove staples; tape is OK)
- ✗ No cereal boxes, cigarette or beverage cartons, paper-type or food boxes (e.g., pizza)

#1 PETE and #2 HDPE PLASTIC BOTTLES



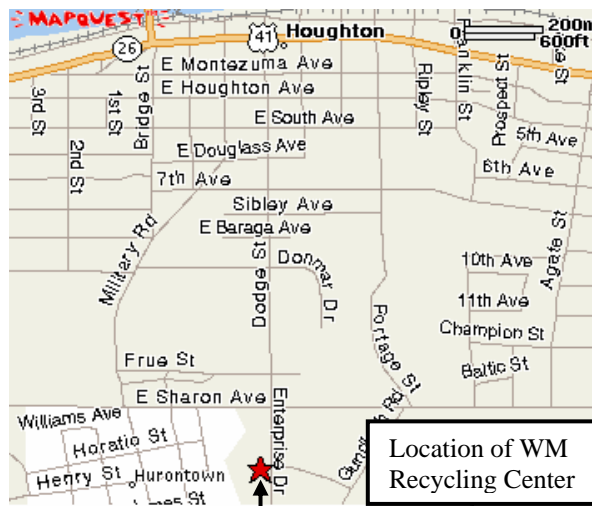
- ✓ Milk jugs, detergent bottles, etc., marked with PETE or HDPE (rinse; remove caps and rings)
- ✗ No plastic other than clear, white, or colored #1 PETE or #2 HDPE (*bottles only*)

METAL CANS and ALUMINUM FOIL

- ✓ Food/beverage cans, jar lids, and aluminum foil (rinse thoroughly and flatten; remove labels)
- ✗ No sheet metal, paint cans, or other scrap

GLASS

- ✗ *No longer accepted* (effective 6/1/06). There is currently no market for glass from the western U.P. Other long-standing recycling programs have also stopped accepting glass for this reason.
